



The AMS MasterKid Program

GUIDELINES FOR 2010-2011

The purpose of the AMS MasterKid Program is to recognize those students who consistently exhibit positive behaviors and academic achievement, as well as those who demonstrate an improvement in these areas.

The following areas are taken into consideration when deciding on which students are eligible for a MasterKid Card:

- attendance
- grades
- behavior infractions

MasterKid Levels:

- *Blue:* A Honor Roll; no more than 4 unexcused* absences; no infractions
- *Black:* A/B Honor Roll; no more than 4 unexcused* absences; 2 or fewer infractions
- *White:* No white cards will be issued first quarter. White cards are issued at teacher/administration discretion where improvement is made in grades, academics, and/or behavior infractions. Students must have no more than 4 unexcused absences.

Infractions include office referrals and lunch detentions. Students who are issued Out of School Suspension are ineligible for a MasterKid Card, and students who possess a card and are issued OSS will have their card revoked immediately. In addition, students who hold a MasterKid card will have it revoked if they receive 5 infractions in a grading period.

Rewards:

- ALL LEVELS: Preferential placement in lunchline on Fridays
Recognition within the school and in local media
Reduced admission fees to athletic events and dances**
Quarterly social with refreshments
End of year Field Trip for those who maintain their card level or achieve a higher level throughout the school year
Discounts at local businesses (specific discounts TBA)
- BLUE LEVEL: Quarterly student/parent breakfast

**Blue Level – free admission, Black and White Levels- \$1 off admission price.

No replacement cards will be issued and students must present their card to receive the incentive at the time it is given.

*In accordance with Stanly County Schools Policy 4050, the following are considered excused absences: illness/injury, quarantine, death in immediate family, medical/dental appointments, court/administrative proceedings, religious observances, or educational opportunity. “The student is responsible to submit a note signed by the parent citing the reason for an absence within two days of the student’s return to school. Failure to comply with the above will result in the absence being unexcused. Absences not classified as excused are unexcused...”
